

- 1 x2 Lower trailing arm skid plates
- 2 x2 Trailing arm brackets
- 3 x6 12mm bolts

Tools needed: 12mm socket



Step 1

On the drivers side install the trailing arm bracket by sliding it in from behind the trailing arm.

Note: Line up the two holes on the trailing arm bracket with the two holes on the trailing arm.



Step 2

Slide the drivers side trailing arm skid plate onto the trailing arm mount.



Note: Hold the trailing arm bracket in place.



Step 3

Install a 12mm bolt to the inner side of the skid plate.

Note: Do not tighten the 12mm bolt.



Step 4


Install two 12mm bolts to the **outer** side of the skid plate.

Note: Do not tighten the 12mm bolts.



Step 5

Tighten the two 12mm bolts.



Step 6

Tighten the 12mm bolt on the inner side of the skid plate.

Repeat process for the other side.
